Aksel Glyholt is the founder of Clientia, a private client-operations platform, and of AG Web Studios, the Danish design-and-engineering studio behind it. A full-stack engineer, he builds end-to-end web platforms with an emphasis on performance, reliability and maintainable architecture.

About

Aksel Glyholt started building for clients early and registered AG Web Studios as a company in 2025, working on real production deployments from the outset. From that studio came Clientia — born from a problem he lived first-hand: running recurring client engagements meant chasing payments, missing renewals, and losing track of which clients were active and which licenses were still running after a project had ended. He wanted billing, access and contract state to always be in sync, in one place. Unable to find that tool, he built it.

Alongside Clientia, he is an active open-source maintainer — his Velocity Limbo Handler, infrastructure that keeps players connected during server downtime, is used across more than a thousand networks. He writes on engineering and design at akselglyholt.com and works from Denmark.
